The Parent and Teen Driving Agreement

Rules land better when a teen helps set them. Go through each line together, fill in the blanks as a family, and both sign at the bottom. Keep it somewhere everyone sees it.

1 Night driving

I will follow Florida's curfew for my age. At 16 that means no driving between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. At 17, none between 1 a.m. and 5 a.m.

OUR FAMILY CURFEW IS _____

2 Passengers

For my first three months licensed, no more than one passenger under 21 who is not family. After that, we decide together.

WHO MAY RIDE WITH ME _____

3 Phone away

My phone goes in the glovebox, in a bag, or on Do Not Disturb before the car moves. No texting, no scrolling, no exceptions. If I need it, I pull over first.

4 Speed and weather

Speed limits are limits, not targets. I will slow down in rain, and if it turns heavy I will pull over somewhere safe and wait it out.

5 Seatbelts, every seat, every time

I buckle up before the car moves, and I do not put the car in drive until everyone else has too.

6 Zero tolerance

No alcohol, no vaping, no drugs, and I will never ride with anyone who has been using them. Florida's limit for drivers under 21 is effectively zero, and so is ours.

The honesty clause, and this one runs both ways

I can call for a ride from anywhere, at any time, for any reason, and there will be no yelling and no punishment for making that call. Getting home safe always beats getting home on time.

IF A RULE GETS BROKEN, HERE IS WHAT WE AGREED HAPPENS

We both agree to this

Signing means we talked it through, we understand it, and we mean it.
